

A BUILDING FOR THE COMMUNITY

You do not need to be a church goer to appreciate the importance of St Mary's Church as a building. The Grade 1 listed church dates back to the 15th century and is a particularly fine example of a medieval building at the heart of its local community.

In addition to formal worship, St Mary's plays an important part in the life of Woodbridge through such events as weddings, baptisms and concerts, as well as special school and civic services. The Friends of St Mary's was formed in January 2012 to support urgently needed repairs to the church tower and other parts of the building.

The Friends raises funds for the continuing upkeep of the church building and its immediate surroundings which are projected to require considerable investment in the future.
